MARCH is a state-wide nonprofit (501c3) mediation program in Missouri. MARCH started as a pilot project in 1997 and served over 300 families this past fiscal year. MARCH currently contracts with 60+ mediators and a dozen limited scope attorneys state-wide. We provide in-person, phone, and virtual mediation options.

## **MARCH Mediation Services:**

### **Free – 4 hours of Mediation per year**

Case type: active IV-D case for separated, divorced or never-married parents only

Eligible families receive up to 4 hours of free mediation services per year

Parties call 1-800-595-9750 to determine eligibility and set up mediation

### **Fee for Service mediation – 2 hours of mediation**

Parties pay \$350 (\$175 each) for 2 hours of mediation services

Parties call 1-800-595-9750 to set up mediation

## **MARCH Contract Attorneys - Free legal services**

Per our Federal grant, a contract attorney via MARCH can assist parties for free with the drafting and filing of paperwork with the court for uncontested IV-D cases. MARCH also pays filing fees.
